

**BY-LAW NO. 51-2000**

**A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW MARYLAND**

**Whereas Section 14(1) of the Police Act, Chapter P-9.2 provides that Council may appoint persons as by-law enforcement officers for the Village of New Maryland,**

*THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW MARYLAND ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:*

- 1.0 This By-law may be cited as "The Enforcement Appointment By-law".
- 2.0 "Council" means the Council of the Village of New Maryland.
- 3.0 By-law Enforcement Officers shall be appointed to such a term as Council may determine.
- 4.0 By-law Enforcement Officers shall take an Oath of Office (Schedule "A").
- 5.0 By-law Enforcement Officers shall be appointed to enforce all Village By-laws and amendments inclusive.
- 6.0 Council may revoke this appointment without cause.
