

VILLAGE OF NEW MARYLAND

BY-LAW NO. 57 - 2009

A BY-LAW RESPECTING DANGEROUS OR UNSIGHTLY PREMISES

Pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 190 of the Municipalities Act, R.S.N.B. 1973, Chapter M-22 and its amendments thereto, the Council of the Village of New Maryland, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as the Village of New Maryland Dangerous or Unsightly Premises By-law.
2. The Council hereby declares that Sections 190.001(1) to 190.07 of the *Municipalities Act*, being Chapter M-22 of the Revised Statutes of New Brunswick 1973 and amendments thereto, and attached hereto as Appendix "A", shall apply to the entire area within the limits of the Village of New Maryland.
3. Village of New Maryland By-law No. 57, A By-law Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises, enacted on December 15, 1993, and all amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.
4. The repeal of Village of New Maryland By-Law No. 57, A By-law Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises, shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceedings for enforcing the same completed or are pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing, or pending at the time of repeal.
