



Tree Mulching Program

Spring 2021

On Monday, May 17th, 2021, Coughlan's Tree Service will **BEGIN** chipping any branches & brush that Village residents would like to dispose of. To ensure pick-up, property owners must have their brush & branches to the curb *on or before May 17th.*



PLEASE NOTE: The Tree Mulching Program is a service provided by the municipality as a means for residents to dispose of branches & brush that have accumulated on their property over the past year. It is **NOT** intended for property owners to clear large amounts of trees or brush from their property. Property owners are responsible to make their own arrangements for disposal of large tree clearing or brush removal projects

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

Property owners are required to place branches & brush at curbside in a manner that does not impede traffic flow and at the time advertised by the Village of New Maryland.

A maximum of one (1) pile for any given property with a size no greater than 2.4m long x 1.22 m wide x 1.22 m high (8 ft x 4 ft x 4 ft) will be collected. Piles larger than these dimensions will be left for the property owner to dispose of at their own expense.

Individual pieces of wood are to be no greater than 150 mm (6 inches) in diameter and no longer than 1.22 m (4 feet) in length. Wood exceeding these dimensions will be left behind for the property owner to dispose of at their own expense.

The contractor will make one (1) pass on each street and the highway to collect brush. Brush that is placed at curbside after the contractor has gone through will be the responsibility of the property owner to dispose of at their own expense.

Sawn lumber, manufactured lumber, or any wood containing nails or fasteners will not be collected. Trees with attached stands and/or decorations will not be collected.
