Sunrise Wellfield Development Project Update Environmental Impact Assessment, Access Road and Water Supply Piping Installation

This Public Notice serves as an update from the Village on the status of our Sunrise Wellfield Development Project. We are pleased to report that we have received the official **Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Determination** and we are eager to move forward with the project.

Council has previously shared commitments with the residents of the Sunrise Estates subdivision regarding their private wells, and we want to further confirm that the conditions of the EIA reinforce those assurances. Under the EIA Determination, Condition 11 states “In the event of a complaint by a neighboring water user that the operation of these water supply wells has negatively impacted the quality or quantity of their private water supply, the proponent (*the Village*) must investigate the complaint and notify DELG (*Department of Environment and Local Government*) according to the manner stipulated in the Approvals to Operate. If it is determined that the proponent is responsible for any negative impacts, the proponent will be required to provide a temporary water supply for short-term impacts, or to repair, remediate, or replace any permanently impacted well(s), which might include, but is not limited to, deepening a well or drilling a new well.” The Village continues with extensive monitoring of the production wells, observation wells and private wells in the area to ensure we are aware of any changes to the water levels.

Construction will be starting in the next few days for Contract # 2. Philson Ltd. has been awarded the Sunrise Wellfield Development Contract 2 which includes the construction of the access road to the well sites, installation of water supply pipe from the well sites to the future treatment plant (located near the Sunrise Park), and installation of the water distribution main from the treatment plant to Route 101. This contract is expected to be completed by November 30, 2021.
