NOTICE OF INTENTION
TO REPEAL AND REPLACE BY-LAW NO. 63

PURSUANT TO SECTION 15(4) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNANCE ACT, S.N.B. 2017, C.18, PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council for the Village of New Maryland intends to repeal By-law No. 63 in its entirety and replace it with proposed By-law No. 63-2022, A By-law Relating to Traffic & Parking in the Village of New Maryland, to harmonize the by-law with the *Local Governance Act*, and to adopt further proposed amendments.

Proposed By-law No. 63-2022 serves:

- 1) to update *New Brunswick Local Governance Act* (“Act”) section references in the by-law to be consistent with the most current version of the “Act”;
- 2) to formally consolidate previous amendments into the by-law;
- 3) to incorporate necessary edits and additions to the definitions section and to the enforcement provisions regarding winter traction tires and parking spaces for disabled persons;
- 4) to update schedules identifying locations of traffic control signage and no parking zones; and
- 5) to standardize document formatting to achieve visual and organizational consistency among all Village by-law documents.

Copies of proposed By-law No. 63-2022 may be inspected at the address below between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding civic holidays, or online at the Village website at www.vonm.ca by searching “Proposed By-laws”.

Village Council will give consideration to the Third and Final Readings of the proposed by-law at the Wednesday, January 19th, 2022, regular meeting of Council commencing at 7:30 p.m.

Out of regard for Covid-19 precautionary measures, members of the public who wish to attend the meeting must pre-register with the Chief Administrative Officer/Clerk, Cynthia Geldart, before 12:00 noon Tuesday, January 18th, 2022.
