15-MINUTE WARNING:

- 1. Wallet, purse, keys, glasses
- 2. Cell phone(s), chargers(s)
- 3. Emergency cash, credit card
- 4. Pet carriers, leashes, medication
- 5. Clothing, shoes, hats for season
- 6. Hearing aids, medication
- 7. Flashlights, extra batteries
- 8. Safety deposit box key(s)

30-MINUTE WARNING (the above plus):

- 1. Pillows, sleeping bags, blankets
- 2. Address book, phone list
- 3. Jewelry & most-valuable personal possessions
- 4. Personal hygiene items
- 5. Other medications, supplements
- 6. First aid kit, medical items
- 7. Pet food, dishes, bedding, litter
- 8. Children's items, toys, books
- 9. Battery radio, extra batteries
- 10. Toilet paper, hand wipes, soap
- 11. Clothing for 3-days, shoes
- 12. Computer, monitor, laptop
- 13. Gallon jugs of drinking water

1-HOUR WARNING:

- 1. Ice cooler w/ice, food, drinks
- 2. Genealogy records, files
- 3. 3-days food, special diet items
- 4. Gloves, dust mask for smoke
- 5. Paper plates, cups, utensils
- 6. School items, homework, pen, pencil, books, calculator, paper
- 7. Licenses, vehicle titles, deeds
- 8. Insurance, financial, medical data, Wills, Powers of Attorney
- 9. Personal property list, photos & appraisals, documentation
