In Case of Emergency

Be 72-Hours Ready

Residents of New Maryland are reminded to have an emergency plan and an emergency preparedness kit that can meet their needs for at least 3 (three) days.

Residents should consider the types of emergencies that could affect their family and community. Natural disasters such as forest fires, hurricanes, storms and flooding, as well as unexpected incidents such as power outages, can occur at any time.

A basic emergency kit should contain the following:

- at least 2 (two)-litres of water per person, per day, for a minimum of 72 (seventy-two)-hours;
- food that will not spoil, such as canned goods, energy bars and dried food;
- cash, debit and credit cards;
- batteries:
- insurance information;
- manual can opener;
- crank or battery-powered flashlights and radio;
- first aid kit;
- extra keys to vehicles and home;
- a copy of your emergency plan and contact information; and
- if applicable, other items such as prescription medications, infant formula, pet food, and equipment for people with special needs (personalize accordingly).

The New Brunswick Emergency Measures Organization (NBEMO) coordinates preparedness for emergencies. It also coordinates provincial response operations during emergencies and administers disaster financial assistance programs during recovery. NBEMO works at the provincial, regional and municipal levels to ensure that communities are protected during all phases of an emergency.
